107 head sold for an average of \$1,415 per head

The highest sold were an Angus X heifer (AI bred) and an Simmental X heifers (AI bred) for \$2,400 each

The lowest sold was an Angus X heifer (Nat bred) for \$950

5 head were Registered Angus – averaged \$1,575 per head

7 head were Angus – averaged \$1,510 per head

72 head were Angus X – averaged \$1,440 per head

10 head were Limousin X – averaged \$1,185 per head

8 head were Simmental X – averaged \$1,650 per head

4 head were Hereford X – averaged \$1,415 per head

1 head was Gelb X – sold for \$1,000

61 head were AI bred (due early February) – averaged \$1,500 per head

49 head were Natural bred – averaged \$1,335 per head

28 head (due early March) – averaged \$1,320 per head

1 head (due mid-March) – sold for \$1,300

9 head (due late March) – averaged \$1,420 per head

1 head (due early April) – sold for \$1,150

7 head (due mid-April) – averaged \$1,315 per head
